This is a 100% tenure track position at the Faculty of pharmacy in the area of fundamental and translational sciences. This area includes both teaching and research activities in pharmacology and pharmaceutical sciences.

It is expected that the focus of the research themes will include areas within the global development and characterization of drugs and their targets. Special attention will be given to research programs in the fields of biological drugs, biotechnologies, as well as the integrative analysis of massive data and IT in health research. Other research themes linked to pharmaceutical sciences could also be considered. The candidate will also need to supervise graduate students (MSc, PhD) in pharmaceutical sciences as well as participate actively to teaching to undergraduate and graduate students within their field of expertise.
