



Université Laval, one of the oldest educational institutions in Canada and the first in North America to offer higher education in French, is seeking applications for a full professor position in the area of clinical pharmacy. This position involves teaching and research activities on the use of pharmacotherapy in humans, and it encompasses the evaluation of technologies and intervention modes used in pharmacy and across the healthcare system.

### ***JOB DESCRIPTION***

The successful candidate will have a tenure-track position at the Faculty of Pharmacy. She or he must participate in teaching undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in any of the professional study programs of the Faculty. She or he will also have to assume leadership in the conduct of scientific projects related to pharmacy, whether on clinical themes (research integrated into care), technological, professional or evaluative. She or he will have to supervise or co-supervise M.Sc. and Ph.D. students.

### ***QUALIFICATIONS***

All candidates must have a Ph.D. (or the equivalent for non-holders of a Ph.D. \*) in pharmacy, pharmacoepidemiology, pharmaceutical sciences or another relevant discipline related to the fields described above. Completion of a postdoctoral fellowship (or equivalent) is considered an asset. Already having a licence to practice pharmacy issued by the Quebec Board of Pharmacists (OPQ) or in other field of health is considered an asset. He or she must have research skills such as the potential to find funding and to publish articles in peer-reviewed journals. The candidate must be able to teach in French and have university teaching experience.
